Bursary Application



What is the Bursary Scheme

RLSS Poole Lifeguard have for many years assisted its members by making available Bursaries to be used towards meeting the costs of Lifeguard, Lifesaving, First Aid, Rescue Boat courses and qualifications. The Club has allocated **£500** to be made available for bursary payments.

How Do I Apply For A Bursary ??

You should apply in writing on the application form supplied by the Club, within one month of commencing or completing your training course or within one month of obtaining the qualification. **Your application should be handed to any Committee Member.**

You should provide the following details on the attached application form;

- Your name & home address.
- Details of the course you attended or are due to attend and any qualifications you have attained or intend to attain.
- The dates of your course and or exam.
- Details of who organised and provided the course and if applicable who assessed your exam.
- The cost of the course and any additional examination fees.
- Details of how you funded this course e.g. personally, parental assistance, PBCLSA or other body assisting towards the fees.
- Details of how you can provide benefit to the club having attended the course and or having attained the qualification.
- Any other comments that you think are relevant.

How Will My Request Be Assessed?

The Executive Committee will consider your request at the next available Committee Meeting occurring after your bursary application is received. Your application will be considered on an individual basis and will take into consideration the following points.

- Your individual current circumstances.
- The course you have attended and it's relevance to the objects of the club.
- Any previous Bursaries granted to you and the level of assistance given.
- Any other club members attending the same course also requesting Bursary payments.
- The availability of the course at other locations throughout the year.
- The financial position of the club at the time of your application.
- You will be notified of the decision of the Executive Committee within 4 weeks of your application being made.

NB; Those requesting assistance for RLSS Trainer or Assessor qualifications should apply in the same way as the bursary scheme. However any financial assistance agreed by the Executive will be separate from the £500 bursary amount allocated this calendar year.
